Scriptures on Children of Abraham

- The birth of Abraham in Ur of the Chaldeans (Iraq) and his marriage to Sarah Genesis 11:27-28.
- "The Call" of Abraham to go from his country and follow God the beginning of "faith" in God Genesis 12:1-3.
- "The Promise" to Abraham of make a great nation of his descendents <u>Genesis</u> 13:14-16; Genesis 15:3-6.
- The marriage of Abraham to Hagar and the birth of Ishmael (meaning "God hears"); the first casting out of Hagar; an angel appears to Hagar regarding her son's descendents <u>Genesis 16</u>.
- God speaks to Abraham promising to make Ishmael the "father of twelve princes" and to "make a nation of the son of the slave woman" <u>Genesis 17:20</u>; <u>Genesis 21:13</u>.
- The birth of Isaac (means "I laughed") to Abraham and Sarah Genesis 21:1-7.
- The second casting out of Hagar <u>Genesis 21:8-14.</u> Hagar calls upon God who sends an angel to comfort her <u>Genesis 21:15-21</u>.
- God's instructions to Abraham to sacrifice his son ("The Binding" of Isaac or Ishmael in <u>Al-Qur'an</u>) – <u>Genesis 22:1-14</u>.
- The second promise to Abraham to bless him and multiply his descendents "as the stars of heaven and as the sand which is on the seashore" <u>Genesis 22:17-18</u>.
- The death of Sarah and her burial in Hebron in the land of Canaan (now Palestine) <u>Genesis 23:1-2</u>.
- Abraham sends his servants back to his country (Iraq) to find a wife for Isaac Genesis 24; later Isaac does the same for his son Jacob Genesis 28:1-5.
- Abraham takes other wives; dies at age 175. Ishmael and Isaac both come to bury their father in Hebron in the land of Canaan <u>Genesis 25:1-11</u>.
- Names of the 12 sons of Ishmael and death of Ishmael *Genesis 25:12-18*.
- Birth of twin sons to Isaac and Rebekkah = Genesis 25:19-26.
- Names of Jacob's sons and grandsons Genesis 46:8-27.
