
Definitions: Hardware and Software

- Hardware refers to objects that you can actually touch, like disks, disk drives, display screens, keyboards, printers, boards, and chips.
 - Hardware has a set of native commands that it can understand and execute
- Software is exists as ideas, concepts, and symbols, but it has no substance.
 - Software is a set of instructions that hope to perform a task using the underlying hardware

Hardware and Software: Comparison

- Types
 - CPU, memory devices, input devices, printers, network
 - System software, application software
- Interdependency
- Maintenance
 - Rarely requires maintenance during life
 - Frequent updates each update needs testing
- Failure
 - Works for its life and then fails
 - Does not degrade with age



- Pretend to be a legitimate enterprise
- Fool recipient into providing personal information
- Large volumes of emails
- Aka brand spoofing or carding
- Spear Fishing targeted fishing


Safety Guidelines

- •If you still get hit by a virus...


Social Networking

Growth in Social Networking




Statistics


- Social networking now accounts for 22% of all time spent online in the US.
- Over 25% of U.S. internet page views occurred at one of the top social networking sites in December 2009, up from 13.8% a year before.
- Australia has some of the highest social media usage statistics in the world. In terms of Facebook use Australia ranks highest with almost 9 hours per month from over 9 million users.
- The number of social media users age 65 and older grew 100 percent throughout 2010, so that one in four people in that age group are now part of a social networking site.




