GMU Terminates Dial-Up Access to Non-GMU Web Sites

GMU has announced that, effective October 1, the University will no longer provide dialup access for students, faculty and staff (terms that include all LRI members) to non-available without charge. GMU-hosted web sites. This means that, while you can continue to send/receive e-mail to/from any addressee, as well as access GMU-hosted web sites, you will need to sign up with another Internet Service Provider (ISP) if you want to access other web sites and have unrestricted access to e-mail (see next paragraph). The notice is posted at http://itu.gmu.edu/dialupends.shtml. For details, click the "FAQ" entry.

In deciding whether you wish to continue to use your GMU account for e-mail (as well as access to GMU-hosted web sites), you should take into account the fact that GMU is drawing the attention of its Internet users to a recently issued Virginia directive stating that Internet resources paid for with State funds are not to be used for personal purposes. The State directive is at http://itu. gmu.edu/internetpolicy/html. This guideline, which GMU considers applicable to LRI and its members, has been in force at GMU for several years but not previously emphasized. "Personal purposes" has not been defined but for LRI members presumably means purposes unrelated to LRI or GMU.

LRI holders of GMU Internet accounts have two basic choices:

- 1. Sign up with another ISP that will give you unrestricted access to the Internet. You might wish to do this if you use the Internet solely or primarily for personal purposes unrelated to LRI or GMU. However, even if you decide you want to use only one ISP, you can retain your GMU account so that you will not lose any e-mails sent to you while you make the transition to another ISP (see paragraph below about forwarding e-mail).
- 2. Retain your GMU account for e-mail related to LRI and/or GMU and for access to

GMU-hosted web sites and also sign up with another ISP for unrestricted access to the Internet. GMU accounts will continue to be

If you decide to use another ISP for your email, you can "instruct" GMU to forward all incoming e-mail messages to your new ISP. You may find this helpful as an interim measure while you inform all your e-mail friends of your new e-mail address. Here's how to do it (courtesy of Virginia Montecino, New Century College, GMU):

- 1. Click on the Windows Start menu
- 2. Then select "RUN"
- 3. In the dialog box type: "telnet mason.gmu. edu"
- 4. Type in your user name at the log-in
- 5. Type in your password when prompted. (It won't show!)
- 6. At the mason.gmu.edu> prompt type: "pico .forward" (Note: Leave a space between pico and the period. Pico is a text editor available on Mason.)
- 7. Press ENTER
- 8. Type the e-mail address where you want to forward your messages. For example:
- "username@aol.com" (Change "username" to your new e-mail name.)
- 9. Press ENTER
- 10. Press CTRL O (the letter O, not zero) to save the file
- 11. Press ENTER to confirm that you want to save the file under the name .forward
- 12. Press CTRL X to exit Pico
- 13. Log out of Mason by typing at the prompt: "logout"

If you wish to save all of your mail, including e-mail sent before the forward command was set, use the WS_FTP program to send your whole mail folder to your desktop, or anywhere else on your computer hard drive.
