LRI Board Meeting Highlights

The LRI Board met on Friday, March 19, at 10:00 at Tallwood. The appointment to the Board of Charles Duggan to fill the vacant term of Don Igo, expiring in May 2006, was unanimously approved.

The Nominating Committee reported on its selection of eight candidates. LRI members will have an opportunity to meet the candidates at the upcoming annual meeting on May 7. A motion was proposed that LRI adopt an absentee balloting procedure in the election of Board officers. This will be voted on at the April 16 meeting of the Board.

It was reported that LRI currently has 645 members and 570 class registrations. Of the 144 memberships up for renewal, 106 have renewed. There are 23 new members and 12 renewals of lapsed memberships.

The following motion was passed: That the LRI closing policy as indicated in the Executive Handbook under Program Item 1 be amended by adding the following sentence: Subject to the availability of the instructor, the week following the end of the regularly scheduled LRI Winter Term is designated to make up classes canceled due to

inclement weather. It was reported that the construction of a stairway outside of TA-1 is now completed.

The next meeting of the LRI Board will be Friday, April 16, at 10:00. Board meetings are generally held on the third Friday of each month. All LRI members are welcome and encouraged to attend.
