## Parking at Tallwood

The first week of classes is always a reminder of how tight our parking is at Tallwood. We often have more cars than spaces and some end up parking along the south side of the pool lot, or on the grass in front of the house, or along the road to the rear, thus blocking traffic or the view of Roberts Road and leading to potential accidents. Remember that we do have several members who have difficulty walking and have reserved spaces for them in front of TA-1. Sometimes our handicapped members arrive a little late and still need to use that space.

Parking along the circle behind TA-1 is restricted to the staff, GMU maintenance workers and instructors while they are presenting classes.

For those of you who park in any of the OLLI lots, please be extra careful when you open your doors, especially if you are parked next to a Corvette or Rolls Royce. Seriously, folks, there is not a lot of room between parking spaces, and where the lots slope, a door can sometimes get away from you. Please be very careful opening your door when you are next to anyone else's car, even a Hyundai. This should reduce complaints from members about dings in their doors. By the way, members who park along Still Meadow Farm Road and Forest Avenue report fewer dings in their doors, so you might try that.
