Dues Increased \$10

At its December meeting, the Board of Directors approved the 2005 budget. Included in the budget is a dues increase of \$10 per member effective with the spring 2005 term. The new dues will be \$280 per year. The dues increase is the first in two years and represents a change of 3.7% as compared to a rise in the cost of living of 5.4% in the same period.

Even with the dues increase, the budget projects a small deficit for 2005. The budget has increased due to a number of factors including higher rent at Lake Anne, printing charges and the introduction of a paid time off plan for the office staff.

Some members have asked why we needed to raise dues in a year when we received a generous grant. The answer is that the grant was made for specific purposes and was not intended to supplement our operating expenses. Therefore, we must continue to rely on dues to cover such costs. The grant proceeds have been used to construct the new restroom at Tallwood and to upgrade the audiovisual equipment in all the classrooms.
