Senator Marsden Speaks to OLLI Audience

On the morning of Monday, Dec 7, around 90 OLLI members gathered at the Church of the Good Shepherd to hear state Senator Dave Marsden (D-37th district) discuss the future of transportation in Northern Virginia. He talked

about Metro, EZ Pass, VRE, the extension of HOT lanes on I-95, and the likelihood of I-66 (inside the beltway) becoming a toll road. Of particular concern to many OLLI members was the possibility that a major transportation hub might someday, in the distant future, be developed along Braddock Road. The senator concluded



by fielding numerous questions from OLLI members concerned about these issues. OLLI member Stephanie Trachtenberg invited Senator Marsden to speak to OLLI, and she also asked OLLI president Glenn Kamber to introduce him. The event was covered by *The Burke Connection*, and once again OLLI landed front-page coverage. Kudos to Stephanie!
