If You Enjoy Learning & Camaraderie, OLLI Provides a Great Bang for Your Buck

- OLLI Mason's annual fee structure of one annual payment for unlimited classes and clubs is a great bargain. For example, in 2021, about 40% of OLLI membership took more than 35 courses over four semesters. At \$450 a year, that averages out to less than \$13 a course, and at the promotional rate of \$300 per year it's only \$8.50 per course. First-time members who are retirees of George Mason University or a northern Virginia school system are eligible for a one-time 12-month membership for only \$150. If you compare this to other organizations that charge on a per course basis, usually \$30-\$50 per course, this represents an enormous savings.
- OLLI offers a payment plan of monthly or quarterly installments by credit or debit card.
- OLLI offers financial assistance for members or prospective members who find it a hardship to pay
