Three things to know about groups:

- **One**: You can find the list of groups and ongoing activities on pages 25-29 of the spring catalog. There are 29 of them!
- **Two**: If you register on the OLLI Portal, you can find the groups under **Ongoing Activities**. However, the club registration process differs from the course registration process. You select **Add To Cart**, and then once you have completed your course selections and prioritization, you must select **Check Out** to get the cart contents into your account. The cart checkout is a separate processing step.
- **Three**: You have to renew your membership in any club for each term; memberships expire at the end of the previous term.

And, of course, if you have a desire for a new club, you can start up another one!
